All Day Rosé

There's something amazingly drinkable about our Rosé, hence the name, All Day Rosé.

Fresh aromas of strawberry, rose petal, pops of cranberry, some subtle spice, a hint of smoke, and peach flesh.

The palate has a pleasing slippery texture, wrapping around peach, pink grapefruit, macerated strawberry and spice.

A nice wash of acid brings the freshness. It's called "All Day Rosé" for its drinkability, no argument there. It's not intense nor wildly complex, but its fresh and zippy aesthetic hits the mark - especially at this price point.

WINE PILOT

Tom Kline

100% grenache made from grapes sourced from the Tscharke family vineyard in Barossa's western ridge.

Kumquat, makrut lime, lime pith, melon, and lemon blossom straight off, with a touch of quince in support.

Nice intensity to the palate, with melon, lime juice, ripe lemon, lemon blossom again and a touch of spice.

There's a good hit of spritely acidity here, drawing the palate in and providing line and carry for the citrus notes.

Really good drinking, this is a wonderful Rosé from Tin Shed Wines to kick back with.

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Sourced from the Tscharke vineyard on the western ridge of the Barossa, this Grenache Rosé is dry and crunchy with savoury highlights.

Vibrant fruit skips out early with watermelon husk, pomegranate and red currants leading the charge. Freeze-dried strawberries quietly work their way forward with a scattering of dried herbs on close.

Nicely done, chill and relax. Drink now.
